

2010-2011 STUDENT SUPPLIES LIST :

ALL ELEMENTARY GRADES 1 to 5

- 30... HB pencils (good quality) {sharpened}
- 6... white vinyl erasers
- 1... highlighter (yellow) - not needed in grade 1
- 1 set... pencil crayons (set of 20)
- 1... black "Sharpie" or Staples brand fine-point (*not* extra-fine) permanent marker
- 1 set... watercolour markers (e.g., Mr. Sketch)
- 1... pencil sharpener
- 2... glue sticks
- 1 bottle... white glue
- 1... plastic ruler (metric)
- 1... pair scissors ('Fiskar' not blunt tips)
- 1... lunch kit
- 1... large backpack

- 1 box... large, freezer weight, Zip Lock bags
- 1... pencil case/kit (large enough to hold pencils, markers, erasers...)
- 2 boxes... facial tissue
- 1 set... inexpensive headphones (same size that would be used with iPod or personal CD player, for grade 1-4 music)
- 1 pair... indoor athletic shoes
- 1 pair... outdoor athletic shoes—
no slip-ons, sandals, clogs etc.
- 1 pair... snow boots for winter activities

GRADE 1

Please do not label any of these supplies as they are used collectively:

- 5... 3-tang report covers (not pocket folders)
- 1... extra pencil sharpener

GRADE 2

Please label the following supplies, as well as the general supplies listed above :

- 1... package fine tipped felt pens
- 6... extra glue sticks
- 1... extra pencil sharpener

Please do not label the following supplies as they are used collectively:

- 10... 3-tang report covers (not pocket folders) multi-coloured
- 2... Hilroy(72 page) exercise books (interlined)
- 2... Hilroy (72 Page) exercise book (1/2 plain, 1/2 interlined)

As well, please do not label the highlighter, "Sharpie", white glue, Zip Lock bags or facial tissue (see general grade 1-5 list above)

GRADE 3

Please do not label any of these supplies as they are used collectively:

- 2... Hilroy (72 page) exercise books (lined)
- 12... 3-tang report covers (not pocket folders)
- 3... extra glue sticks
- 1... extra pair of scissors
- 1... extra pencil sharpener
- 4... extra vinyl erasers

GRADE 4

Please do not label supplies as most are used collectively

- 12... 3-tang report covers (not pocket folders, not plastic) in the following colours: 2 green, 2 red, 2 yellow, 2 white, 2 blue, and 2 orange. Please do not substitute colours, or label these with your child's name!
- 1... 200 sheet package lined hole punched looseleaf paper
- 1... 50 sheet package 5mm graph paper
- 3... extra highlighters
- 2... rolls of scotch tape
- 6... extra glue sticks
- 1... package fine-tipped markers
- 1... pkg of 12 oil pastels, labeled w/student's name & Home Rm
- 1... pkg of 12-15 small Hot Glue sticks
- 1... basic calculator, labeled w/student name & Home Rm
- 1... 22.9x30.5 cm ringed Hilroy sketch book
- 1... extra pair of scissors (optional)

KINDERGARTEN

Please label the following supplies:

GRADE 5

- 10... 3-tang report covers (not pocket folders) - not labeled
- 3... two-pocket folders
- 1... binder (1 ½ ")
- 2... 200 sheet packages lined looseleaf paper (regular size, style and hole-punching please)
- 5... extra tabbed page dividers
- 1... journal (agenda size)
- 5... Pens
- 1... pkg of 12 oil pastels
- 1 ... pkg fine-tipped dry erase markers
- 1 ... pkg medium/chisel tip dry erase markers (optional)
- 2... fine point **and** 1 ultra-fine point black "Sharpie" markers (or Staples house brand)

2010-2011 STUDENT SUPPLIES LIST GRADES 6-12

Student Supplies vary greatly for Grade 6-12 students depending on course selections. Courses needing specific additional supplies will be circulating their lists at the beginning of term. The following basic supplies are suggested for all grade 6-12 students—

- 1... water bottle
 - 30... HB pencils (good quality) {sharpened}
 - 10... ball-point pens (blue or black)
 - 1... set of 20 pencil crayons or coloured markers
 - 3... highlighters
 - 1... pencil sharpener
 - 6... white vinyl erasers
 - 1... white-out tape
 - 3... glue sticks
 - 1... roll of scotch tape
 - 1... box of reinforcements
 - 2... plastic rulers (metric)
 - 1... geometry kit
 - 1... pair of scissors ("Fiskar", not blunt tips)
 - 1... scientific calculator* (please see "Some Specifics" below)
 - 3... 200 sheet packages lined looseleaf paper
 - 1... package graph paper, 1/2 cm square
 - 1... package blank paper
 - 12... clear sheet protectors
 - 10... tabbed page dividers
 - 1... box of facial tissues
- Binders: 1 1/2" for each class, or large zippered binder to hold materials for all classes
- 1... pencil case
 - 1... lunch kit
 - 1... large backpack
 - 1... Dictionary
 - 1... Thesaurus

Students are encouraged to purchase a "memory stick" to be able to bring computer files to and from school.

SOME SPECIFICS...

- All **Math 10-20-30** students require a Texas Instruments TI 83-plus **OR** TI 84-plus calculator (with full instruction manual).
- Students taking **Spanish and/or French** will need a Collins, Larousse or Universal Spanish/English or French/English Dictionary. Please provide index cards (recipe cards) for all Spanish classes.
- **Grade 7 students** will be receiving an email from their home room teacher indicating the additional supplies needed for that class.

Students are strongly urged to leave valuable items and electronic devices (iPods, etc.) at home!

Student Timetables/ Home Rooms will be distributed via e-mail by the last week of August.

Grade 6-12 Phys Ed students will need:

- Complete change of appropriate gym clothing: track/sweat pants, shorts, T-Shirt, running shoes (not flip-flops, slip-ons, etc.) and weather—appropriate outdoor footwear. Students are expected to be prepared to be in- or out-doors everyday regardless of weather
- **combination lock or small padlock, for locker room.** Personal items must never be left unsecured in the locker room! Once PE class is over, the padlock must be removed and the tote emptied.
- For Grade 9-12 Phys Ed students, city bus passes/tickets are highly recommended. (If purchasing a pass, keep each pass *and receipt* for tax savings!)
