ROLE OF THE TEACHER

BACKGROUND

The success of the school system depends to a significant extent upon the caliber of its professional staff. The Charter Board expects its teachers to demonstrate the academic and professional competence necessary to work cooperatively in the general instruction of students, motivated by the general educational goals of the Charter Board.

The Principal is responsible for the implementation of this administrative procedure.

PROCEDURES

1. Teachers shall work in cooperation with the Principal to ensure students are provided with an education appropriate to their needs and abilities, and adequate supervision to protect their health, safety, and well-being.
2. Teachers are further expected to work with the Principal toward achieving Westmount's vision, mission, philosophy and guiding principles, and the goals of the plans developed at the school level.
3. Teachers are to comply with the relevant statutes of the Government of Alberta, the Teaching Quality Standard, Charter Board policy and administrative procedures, and policies and procedures developed at the school.
