STUDENT DRESS CODE

BACKGROUND

Standards of dress should ensure an atmosphere conducive to learning.

Consistent with its belief that each student is a unique individual, Westmount does not support a school uniform.

The superintendent delegates to the principal the responsibility for establishing and enforcing a Student Dress Code.

PROCEDURES

1. The principal shall develop a Student Dress Code in consultation with staff and school council.
2. The dress code shall be reasonable and respectful of the diverse cultural and socio-economic background of the student population.
3. Any violations of this administrative procedure will be addressed in accordance with AP-340 Student Code of Conduct, AP-350 Student Discipline, and AP-351 Suspension.
