

### Course Selection Current Grades 6-11 Students - Begins March 12th.

Throughout the month of March, Student Services and Administration will be meeting with students currently in grade 6 through 11 to discuss course selection for the 2019-2020 school year. Course selection for students will open **Thursday, March 12th** and close **Friday, March 20th**. In order to complete course selection, students will need to have their PowerSchool login and password, which can be obtained from their SOURCE teacher.

Course selection presentations to students will be held:

- Gr 6 into 7** (March 6th 8:30 - 9:30 Cafeteria)
- Gr 7 into 8** (March 6th 9:45 - 10:30 Learning Commons)
- Gr 8 into 9** (March 6th 8:45-9:30 Learning Commons)
- Gr 9 into 10** (March 4th 9:50-10:30 Learning Commons)
- Gr 10 into 11**, (March 3rd 9:50-10:30 Learning Commons)
- Gr 11 into 12** (March 2nd 9:50 - 10:30 Learning Commons)

#### **What will be highlighted:**

- Core and Complementary Courses *potentially* offered for 2020-2021  
\*Course selection is an important process for mid-high, as we make decisions on what to offer based on demand. If demand for a course is high based on course selection, we do our best to accommodate. Alternatively, if demand is low, we reduce classes and staffing. Thus, while advertised in the course selection process, courses will be offered only if enrollment supports.
- Important transition information for 8 to 9, as well as 9 into 10.
- For current grade 9 - 11's, graduation requirements and potential post-secondary requirements will be discussed.
