Addressing our traffic concerns

We are currently working with the city of Calgary to make the following changes around our school:

Bus Loading Zone (No Stopping)

Change the existing signage along Uxbridge Drive NW from No Parking to No Stopping in the Bus Loading Zone. This adjustment will allow the Calgary Parking Authority to more effectively enforce restrictions and ensure the area remains clear for school buses.

Passenger Loading Zone (No Parking)

Add a Passenger Loading Zone on Utah Drive to create a 10-minute loading area for parents during school hours. This will discourage long-term parking by residents, support short, efficient drop-offs and pick-ups, and help keep traffic moving smoothly.

Mid-block Crosswalk

The City of Calgary is continuing to review options for a potential mid-block crosswalk on Uxbridge Drive NW. They are working with the Community Association to determine the best solution, depending on whether the parking lot remains open or closed to traffic.

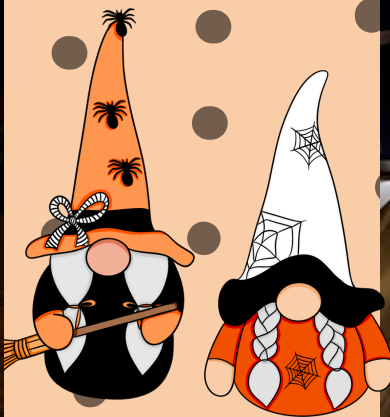

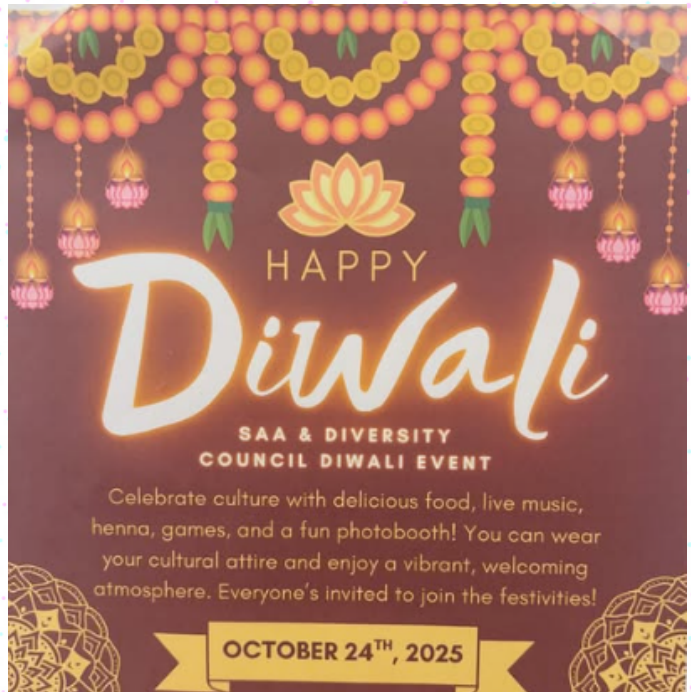
