



WCS Annual Extracurricular Athletics Consent Form

Consent for Participation

I, the parent/guardian of the student mentioned earlier (or the student if independent under the Education Act), acknowledge that extracurricular competitive athletics occur outside the regular physical education curriculum and carry increased risk of injury. I give consent for my child to participate in any of the following extracurricular athletic activities during the current school year:

- Badminton
- Basketball
- Cross country
- Curling
- Golf
- Rugby
- Track and Field
- Volleyball
- Wrestling

Medical Information

I will ensure my child's medical and emergency contact information is up to date in PowerSchool with any relevant medical information that may affect my child's participation (allergies, injuries, medical conditions, medications, etc.).

Eligibility for Female-Only Divisions

In accordance with Alberta's Fairness and Safety in Sport Act (Bill 29):

- Participation in female-only divisions is limited to students who are biologically female.
- Verification of biological sex may be required for female-only divisions.

I understand that this information will be kept confidential and used solely for the purpose of eligibility verification.

Co-Ed / Mixed-Sex Divisions

Students not eligible for female-only divisions, including transgender and non-binary students, may participate in co-ed or mixed-sex divisions where offered.

By completing the form in registration, I acknowledge that:

1. I have read and understand the risks associated with extracurricular athletics.
2. I consent to my child's participation in the activities listed above.
3. I have provided accurate medical information and understand that it will be treated confidentially.
4. I understand and will adhere to the eligibility requirements for female-only divisions and co-ed/mixed-sex opportunities.
